

Bring this completed form along with your model to the **LSOL.com booth**. We will enter you in the contest and **will show you where to take your model**. ALL models must be entered BEFORE 10:30am on Saturday. Models can be picked up no earlier than 2 hours before the close of the last day of the show to be eligible for judging and prizes.

You can enter only one entry per category, with a maximum of three entries per contest. Any commercially built models are not eligible to be entered in the contest. **There is no entry fee to enter this contest, however you will need to provide your own entry into the show to enter your model. Entering the contest does not provide free admission to the show.** The person entering the contest must select the category that they best feel represents their entry. This entry can not have been entered in this year if it has been entered in any other LSOL.com model contest, in any other year, whether it won or not. Judges may enter the contest, but must excuse themselves from judging the category in which they have an entry. **You do not need to be a member of LSOL.com to enter this contest.**

Category Details

(A) Dioramas:

Any model incorporated into a display with other models, figures, etc. that tells a story or presents a snapshot of an activity.

Kitbashing:

A commercially available, assembled product or kit that has been modified.

(B) Self-Propelled: (Example: Engines, Trolley, Trains, etc) Items entered into this category must be self-propelled so that the unit has the ability to move on the track. Engines with rolling stock constitute a train.

(C) Rolling Stock: These can be any item that is drawn behind a engine that does not have its own motor that is used to move the unit on the track.

(D) Structures: A bridge or building that was created from a commercially available kit or a pre-built unit that has been modified or changed with additional parts.

Scratch Built:

A model built primarily from scratch or assembled from a variety of other components. At least 51% of the model must be made from parts created by the modeler.

(E) Self-Propelled: (Example: Engines, Trolley, Trains, etc) Items entered into this category must be self-propelled so that the unit has the ability to move on the track. Engines with rolling stock constitute a train.

(F) Rolling Stock: These can be any item that is drawn behind a engine that does not have its own motor that is used to move the unit on the track.

(G) Structures: A bridge or building in which the model parts were fabricated by the builder with a limited quantity of commercially available items added for detail.

(H) Whimsical:

This model should be fun. It can be from a kit or scratch built. It can be an engine, trolley, train, rolling stock, building, bridge or any combination of the above. It can be in scale, out of scale, or out of this world. The items entered should be in the 1:32 to 1:20.3 scale range.

Prizes:

Ribbons: First, Second and Third place ribbons will be awarded in **each** of the categories: A-B-C-D-E-F-G-H at each show.

Prizes: There are gift certificates awarded at each show. The total award amounts for each prize are: Best of Show-\$1000MSRP, 1st Place Over All-\$500MSRP, 2nd-Place Over All-\$200MSRP, 3rd-Place Over All-\$100MSRP. Any entry is eligible to win a gift certificate. The prizes from Aristo-Craft and St Aubins **cannot** be combined and **must** be redeemed from the respective company that provided the awarded prize. The Judges' decisions as binding and final.
